PARTICIPATING IN THE BUCKTOWN HOLIDAY ARTSHOW

For its 11th year, the Bucktown Holiday ArtShow selects about 100 artists to display and sell their art to eager and anxious holiday shoppers. The Bucktown Holiday ArtShow offers art of all media - from photography to textiles, water colors to oils, and jewelry to ceramics. Come celebrate and share your unique, one-of-a-kind artwork.

DATE AND LOCATION

The Bucktown Holiday ArtShow is held at Holstein Park Fieldhouse, 2200 N. Oakley Ave., Chicago, IL 60647 on December 12-13, 2009 from noon to 5pm each day. The Fieldhouse is nestled in the heart of Bucktown next to the popular Holstein Park and Senior Citizens' Park. Setup is held 5-7pm on Friday night. Artists may continue set up at 10:30am Saturday, and the Fieldhouse closes at 5:30pm. Entry on Sunday for artists is 11am, and tear down must be completed by 7pm.

PICKING A SPACE (Gym or Auditorium)

All spaces are no larger than six feet by six feet. You may choose between an auditorium space or a space in one of two gyms. The main entrance opens into the auditorium with customers entering the ArtShow through this main entrance. The elevator also opens into the auditorium. The two gyms are accessible through doors located at two corners of the auditorium.

SILENT AUCTION

A Silent Auction takes place during the ArtShow. Each artist donates an item of their own work for the Silent Auction. A surcharge may be paid in lieu of donating to the Silent Auction.

ARTIST INFO

The ArtShow is open to artists of all media. Artists may only sell their own work. The Bucktown Holiday ArtShow is a juried ArtShow which will only consider original works of art made by the artist applying for the ArtShow. To maintain quality and integrity of the ArtShow, you will not be allowed to sell items that you have not submitted as exemplary of your work for jurying with your application or identified as media offered for sale at the ArtShow. For example, if you are a photographer who submitted examples of photography for the jury, you may not sell jewelry along with your photography.

We suggest staging a mock-up of your space prior to the ArtShow. You, your work and your entire display must fit within the dimensions of your space. Tables are available for rental, or you may bring your own table or tables. Tables larger than six feet may not be used. Chairs are not provided, nor are they available for rental.

Artists must submit at least two slides or photos along with their application UNLESS you participated in a previous Bucktown Holiday ArtShow and have not significantly changed your work or your media.

You will be notified of acceptance as soon as possible. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS AFTER THE MAILING DATE OF YOUR NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE FOR ANY REASON**
